Meeting Minutes: November 10, 2008

Mary Lou opened the meeting thanking all of the parents for their support during the 10 weeks of the marching season. WE APPRECIATE EVERYONE'S EFFORTS.

Thanks for all of your help this season. WE couldn't have done any of this without the help of everyone.

AmeriKam sent us a \$1,000.00 donation for Ireland. It is a company out of Grand Rapids, Michigan. One of our dad's spoke to the owner about our trip to Ireland.

Beth Sewell will be writing out thank you notes for the different people who have

helped out this marching season and donated to the Ireland fund.

Beth Sewell went over the meeting minutes from the October meeting.

It has been decided to hold a dance for the Headdy family in honoring Jesiah during his battle against cancer. The dance will be January 3, 2009 from 7 PM – 11PM at Eagle's Landing. The price for students will be \$4.00 with a non perishable food item or \$5.00 without a food item. Band parents will chaperone and cover the clean-up. Diana Fellure is going to contact Mark Allem about being our DJ for the evening.

Vickie Frye talked about the budget. The next fair share payments are for December 8th and January 15. Everything is under budget. We are looking good. Transportation came in under budget for a total of \$1,846.00. Vickie noted that the October recharge has not been posted yet for Kroger cards. Football concessions will be posted soon. (I just gave her the info last night.) Let Vickie know what you want to do with the credit balances in your account(s). New Horizon's will take care of matching up the funds for the Ireland trip.

Mr. Wells talked about the season. If you haven't heard ... we were 8th tied with Scottsburg. You are able to look at the trophies that are from Regionals, Semi-state, and State . Mr. Wells explained that we didn't perform the show at the sectional game because we left the show at Lucas Oil Stadium. Mr. Wells thanked us for the food, water, help, support, breakfasts, lunches, dinners, support, food, support, help (you get the picture).

Some of the band's firsts this year are: We were the 1st back to back state finals band in Edgewood History. We were the last to march at the RCA Dome and 1st at Lucas Oil Stadium. We were involved in the first semi-state in ISSMA history. The kids marched a very challenging show—if not the best in the state. Mr. Wells feels that we have a great bunch of kids. He wanted us to know that other people knew that we were much better than 8th. Judges didn't see what we wanted them to see, and we are very proud of them.

For the future ... basketball schedule will be coming home this week. The band plays for many girls' games and many boys' games but not every game. Jazz I and II will begin. The first contest will be at Bloomington North. We will also be going to

the Purdue Jazz festival in Lafayette. We won't be going to as many festivals this year due to the Ireland trip. There is going to be a Christmas concert, probably the week before Christmas.

Ireland practices will begin in February. They will be right after school until 5:00 PM to get ready for the parade. This will go through the month of February and possibly the first two weeks of March. **Fundraisers**

**Band Camp—Mr. Wells talked about the upcoming week of band camp being held at DePauw University in Greencastle Indiana. We are inside all day. We are leaving here on Sunday, July 20<sup>th</sup>, loading and preparing at 11:30, we are leaving the high school at 1:30 PM.**

**Mr. Wells stressed to the students to wake up on time and do not be late to rehearsal. Breakfast @ 7:00 AM. 8 – 12 marching drill; 12 – 1 lunch; 1 – 5 sectionals;;5 – 6 dinner ;6 – 10 rehearsal. We will see a movie at the Greencastle Cinema, Batman if we can get in. We will probably do this on Wednesday or Thursday. Students are to be in their rooms by 11:00. No boys in girls' rooms, no girls' in boys' rooms. No boys on girls' floors, no girls on boys' floors. 11:30 lights out—students may stay up late, but there are no exceptions to in rooms at 11:00 lights out at 11:30. Every school rule applies. No alcohol, if found/caught you will be sent home, your parents will have to come and pick you up. Mr. Wells did not feel it necessary to have Mr. Ackerman talk to the kids.**

**Every student needs a white T-shirt every day. You are expected to take care of the campus, pick up your trash, no gum, no graffiti, no tearing up....What to take with you, instrument, water bottle—this is not an option. Please send your kid prepared. Bath stuff, towels, soap, shampoo, flip flops, alarm clock. One person in the room NEEDS to bring in an alarm clock. Comfortable clothes for six days. EVERY STUDENT NEEDS A WHITE T-SHIRT FOR EVERY DAY! They also need socks, (two pair per day recommended). The morning routine would be basics. Tennis shoes, cross country, or running shoes are recommended. Skate boarding shoes not really recommended, no FLIP FLOPS or Sandals during rehearsals.**

**Toiletries needed—Deodorant is very important. We sweat and then you stink. We are in close quarters, we don't want to smell. Please remember your personal hygiene so that you don't stink please bring it. Also bring a hat for those of you outside (drum line and guard) No TV's, but you can bring pictures and posters—as long as it is school appropriate. No tape on**

**the walls. NO pins, no tacks, no marks on the walls—**

**Place markers. Duck tape works the best. However, you can use what you have.**

**Penny Arnold talked about the cost of a lost room key . We have heard that the replacement cost is \$50.00. Parents will be billed for the lost key. If there is damage in your room, please let the chaperone know. We can tell the Hall Supervisor so that we will not be charged for the damage. Please bring your own "nurse" needs: Tylenol, Advil, band-aids, tums, and money for pizza.**

**At this point we were began to discuss the Ireland trip and fundraisers. There will be some scholarships made available. Sam Emmons went over the Golf Scramble being held on October 5<sup>th</sup>. Maryanne went over the Gala fundraiser. She introduced the chair people and their jobs.**

**Mr. Wells gave an update on the trip. Nothing has changed; the only thing different is the payment. August 15, 2008. \$260.00 is due at that time. **Band Camp Update—Bliss Isom. Health forms need to be filled out and turned in tonight or at the mandatory meeting on July 16, 2008. Band camp is at DePauw University July 20 – 24, 2008. There will be more information to come via e-mail. We also need to have background checks filled out for the chaperones. Students cannot go to band-camp without the health form filled out.**

**We also discussed chaperone duty. You can just stay overnight and go to work during the day. You can just come for a day or two. We will take what we can get.**

#### **Director's Comments and Trip Overview**

**Trip cost is \$2,260.00. New Horizon's packet of information lays out the different options. Leave on Friday before Spring Break. Depart from EHS to Chicago via charter bus. We will go straight to the tarmac to load the plane. All of our equipment will be together. We will be on a bus for 4 hours and the air for 12! We will be seeing a lot of things in Ireland. Saturday, Sunday, and Monday are all sightseeing days. On Tuesday, we will be doing the parade, and then enjoy some time in Dublin. Wednesday is another sightseeing day ending with a traditional Irish Evening. We leave on Thursday.**

**We're basing this trip on 80 people participating. If we get more than 80, the price will begin going down. If we have 70 , the trip will cost slightly more.**

**If we have to split flights, then we would have a school person on each flight. Example given was Mr. Wells on one fight and Mr. Ackerman on another flight.**

**Room selections are priced differently. Students will have a price of \$2,260.00. Parents/chaperones can have double or single rooms at a higher rate. Cost for a double room is \$2,469 or single room is \$2,839.00. Adult chaperones are eligible for quad rooms; they just need to put this on their form.**

**First payment is due on July 15, 2008 – August 15, 2008. Mr. Wells then outlined the payment/fundraiser options, how fundraiser money will be applied, and travel insurance and pros and cons. Travel insurance cost is \$69.00 per person. Travel protection plan information will be on the band website. The question was asked if the insurance covers instruments. The assumption is yes, but Mary Lou and Mr. Wells will be checking into this.**

**Luggage was then discussed. We have to keep luggage to one suitcase at 50lbs. Probably 10lbs will be the band uniform alone. Pack LIGHT! You also have one carry one. If you are a clarinet or a flute player, you will pack your instrument. The larger instruments will be in cargo. As of right now, the airlines companies are not going to charge for the extra luggage....however, that is always subject to change. We don't know that for sure as of now.**

**Mr. Wells also suggested that the students get a pre-paid debit or credit card. Ask your bank about the charges they will assess you. Students will not necessarily need extra money. The cost of the trip covers everything. They may want spending money. Mr. Wells suggested \$100.00 to \$150.00.**

**Passports were then discussed. EVERY ONE GOING ON THE TRIP WILL REQUIRE A PASSPORT. If you already have one please check the expiration date. Ireland and the US would like for your passport to not be 6 months from expiration. Documentation needed was provided. The last day for the passport application is October 1, 2008. The passport is good for 5 years, 10 for adults and students over 16. CVS will take the pictures for you for \$7.95; The Monroe County Courthouse, and the Post Office in Downtown Bloomington will take passport applications.**
